

MCJRP eligibility- Identified by DA

Treatment Readiness Dorm:

Target population (in order of priority):

- JRP pre-adjudicated defendants
 - JRP sentenced to probation defendants
 - Non-JRP sentenced defendants.
- (Inmates in lock down or med holds are not eligible) Requests for review from client, PO or parties

Judicial settlement Conference

Probation Services

MCJRP Intensive supervision:

Target population:

- High risk/High need
- Medium risk/High need
- Presumptive prison sentences
- History of MH, SO, DV, or Gang will be assigned to that unit for supervision.

Referral process:

- Sentenced by JRP Judge.

FSAP supervision

Target Population:

- Presumptive prison cases
- Parenting children.

Referral Process:

- Internal DCJ screen

START Court:

Target population:

- High risk overall LSCMI
- Very High need A/D problem
- High/Very high on antisocial pattern
- Presumptive prison sentence.
- No significant MH issues, will not impair completing court requirements.
- No DV/SO conditions
- Available custody units

Referral process:

- CJM or Lead PPO screen for START

DISP Court:

Target Population:

- Repeat DUUI clients
- Alcohol is primary behavior for risk.
- High risk for impaired driving.

Referral process:

- Anyone can refer
- No automatic exclusions to the program.
- Voluntary entry
- Set JSC in DISP court
- Program orientation attendance required
- IDA assessment needs to be high.

Mental Health Court:

Target population

- Diagnosis or serious persistent mental illness (formally Axis I)
- Substance Abuse and personality disorders are secondary to mental illness.
- No SO conditions.
- DV case by case basis.

Referral process:

- Open referral process (anyone can refer)
- Can be a probation transfer.
- Obtain application for MH court JA & submit with available MH records.
- MH Court Judge holds consideration hearing.
- Participation in MHC is voluntary.

Generic supervision:

- **Out of State:** Lives or is supervised in another state, will be allowed to move.
- **Out of County:** Is supervised already or lives in another county.
- **Opt Outs:** Defendants that do not want to be part of the process.

Other Courts:

- **STOP:** non adjudicated conditional discharge felonies. Low risk/high need.
- **Veteran's Docket:** PV docket for veterans with access to benefits (under discussion).
- **Community Court**
- **DV/DSP deferred Sentencing**
- **DUII Diversion**
