



## PROJECT INFORMATION

### About:

Travelers should plan for up to 30 minute delays on I-5 between Woodburn and Salem. Over 12 miles of road will be paved, including six bridges. Expect most work to be done overnight. Lane closures will begin as early as 7 p.m. and continue as late as 9 a.m. Safety enhancements include:

- Electronic monitoring will inform drivers of road conditions and delays.
- Traffic lanes will use the shoulder for a wider safety buffer between workers and vehicles.
- Portable message signs will give drivers advance notice of upcoming work.
- Oregon State Police will monitor work zones at all times.

In addition we are grinding and replacing bridge panels through Salem which creates a rough uneven surface. Stay alert and slow down in the work zone.
