The organization you choose to perform your COMMUNITY SERVICE hours with must be a NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION registered with State of Oregon. Make contact with the organization. Inform the organization that you have Court ordered Community Service to complete. The agency must know the nature of your conviction, the convicted charges and the number of hours ordered.

Once you have completed the court ordered community service, you must provide the court with proof of hours worked.

Verification of days and hours completed must be submitted to the court on the non-profit agency's letterhead and include their contact information and non-profit Tax ID #.
