**DOMESTIC RELATIONS
TRIAL PROCESS SELECTION**

and

Unmarried children 18, 19, or 20 years old (per ORS 107.108) (full names)

Parties in a domestic relations case have a choice about how they want their trial to be conducted:

(1) Traditional trial. Both parties can call witnesses and question witnesses called by the other party. Oregon Rules of Evidence apply.

or

(2) Informal Domestic Relations Trial (IDRT) under UTCR 8.120. The ability to call witnesses may be limited for both parties. Oregon Rules of Evidence do not apply. Both parties must select IDRT or a traditional trial will be conducted. Check with your court for more information about the IDRT process.

INFORMAL DOMESTIC RELATIONS TRIAL (IDRT) under UTCR 8.120

- I agree to waive the normal question-and-answer manner of trial
- I agree the court may ask me questions about the case
- I agree to waive the rules of evidence in this IDRT
 - The court will consider any document or physical evidence a party submits
 - Both parties can tell the court anything they feel is relevant
- I understand that:
 - My participation in this IDRT process is strictly voluntary and no one can force me to agree to this process
 - The court will decide how much weight to give to documents, physical evidence, and testimony that is entered as evidence during the IDRT
 - I am confident I understand the IDRT process
- I have not been threatened or promised anything for selecting the IDRT process
