Oregon Judicial Department Seeks Comments on Proposed Fee Revision for Online Access to the Oregon Judicial Case Information Network

NOTICE OF PROPOSED FEE INCREASE, OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

Oregon Judicial Case Information Network (OJCIN)

July 3, 2025

The Oregon Judicial Department (OJD) has opened a public comment period on proposed fee increases for use of the Oregon Judicial Case Information Network (OJCIN). The OJCIN system provides both free and paid online access to calendar and other court information, including case documents. Comments on the proposed fee schedule are due no later than 5 p.m. on August 4, 2025.

The proposed fees are outlined in Chief Justice Order 25-021. If adopted, the revised fees would take effect on September 1, 2025, and continue to offset the costs of providing electronic access to court documents, technology support services, maintenance costs, hardware and software replacement, and other costs relating to state court electronic systems.
