Vision

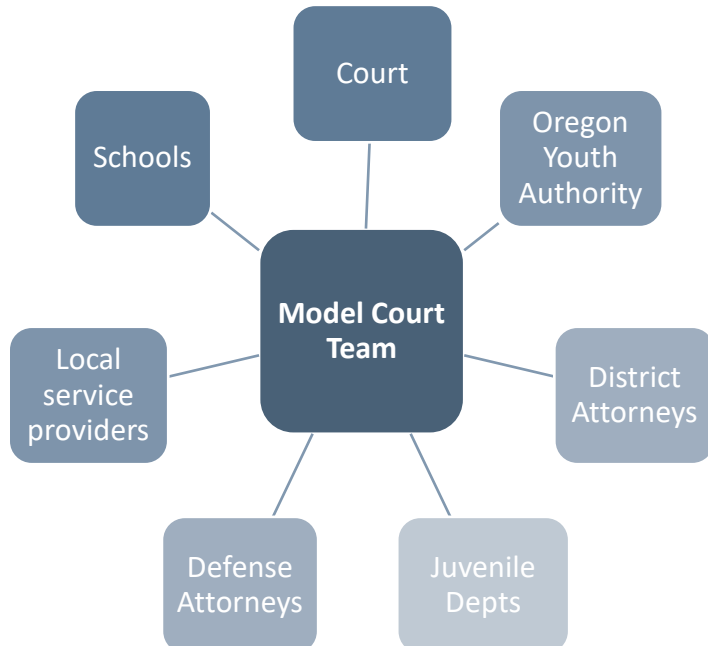
Representatives from local courts and juvenile justice system partners working together to assess local system needs and make improvements.

Purpose

Provide a vehicle for locally directed, state supported efforts to improve the juvenile court's handling of delinquency cases. Efforts should be collaborative, inclusive, multidisciplinary, and consider system partners' roles and responsibilities in improving outcomes for justice-involved youth.

Recommended Team Members

Delinquency Model Court Teams (MCTs) should include local system partners needed to effectively identify, prioritize, and implement system improvements. The team's membership may change depending upon the focus of its project(s).



MCTs understand their local issues and strengths and are best positioned to identify priorities and projects that will have an impact. JDIP can provide support and resources to achieve team goals.

Important Considerations for Effective Teams

- **Be intentional** about your team members
- **Seek diversity** in experience and thinking
- **Consider size** of team and its impact on functioning
- **Include right people @ right time** for the focus of the meeting
- **Identify team "managers"** to keep team on track, take notes, etc.
- **Be clear and specific** about member expectations
- **Be transparent** about roles and decisions.



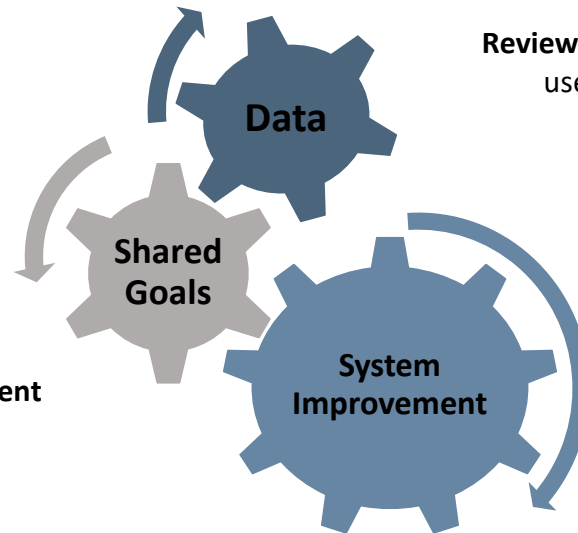
Delinquency Model Court Teams

An Effective Model Court Team

Holds **regular meetings** with a standing agenda of system improvement focused projects

Has a **record of meetings** like minutes or a project tracker

Focuses on **system improvement**



Reviews OJD and JJIS data regularly and uses it to identify projects and track progress

Collaborates to identify and develop projects

Has specific goals and a **shared commitment** to achieving them
