Definitions

child in care

maltreatment

out-of-home ca investigation A person under 21 years of age residing in or receiving care or services from:

- A child-caring agency or proctor foster home;
- A foster home certified by the Department; or
- A developmental disabilities residential facility; unless
- The care is being provided to the child by the child's parent



Performance Measure

The rate of victimization per 100,000 days of foster care of all the children in foster care during a rolling 12-month period.

Of the total number of days children spend in foster care in care during a 12-month period, how many instances of abuse were there for every 100,000 days.
