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Abuse of a Child in Care

Definitions

child in care

maltreatment

out-of-home care investigation

A person under 21 years of age residing in or receiving care or services from:

- A child-caring agency or proctor foster home;
- A foster home certified by the Department; or
- A developmental disabilities residential facility; *unless*
- The care is being provided to the child by the child's parent

Definitions ➡

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Definitions ➡	• Wrongfully taking assets, funds, or property that belong to or are intended for the use of a child in care. • Alarming a child in care by conveying a threat to wrongfully take or appropriate money or property of the child in care if the child would reasonably believe the threat conveyed would be carried out. • Misappropriation, misuse, or transfer of any money without authorization from any account held jointly or singly by a child in care. • Failure to use the income or assets of a child in care effectively for the support and maintenance of the child in care. • Financial exploitation does not include age-appropriate discipline that may involve the threat to withhold, or the withholding of, privileges.
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Definitions ➡	ORS 419B.005 • Any assault, as defined in ORS chapter 163, of a child and any physical injury to a child which has been caused by other than accidental means, including any injury which appears to be at variance with the explanation given for the injury. ORS 418.257 • Any physical injury to a child in care caused by other than accidental means or that appears to conflict with the explanation given of the injury; or • Willful infliction of physical pain or injury upon a child in care. 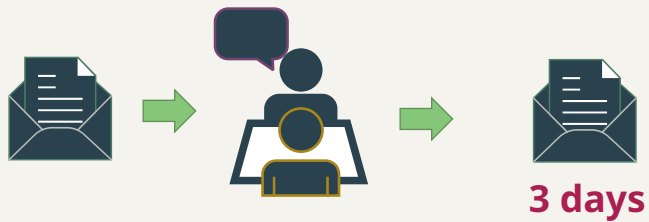

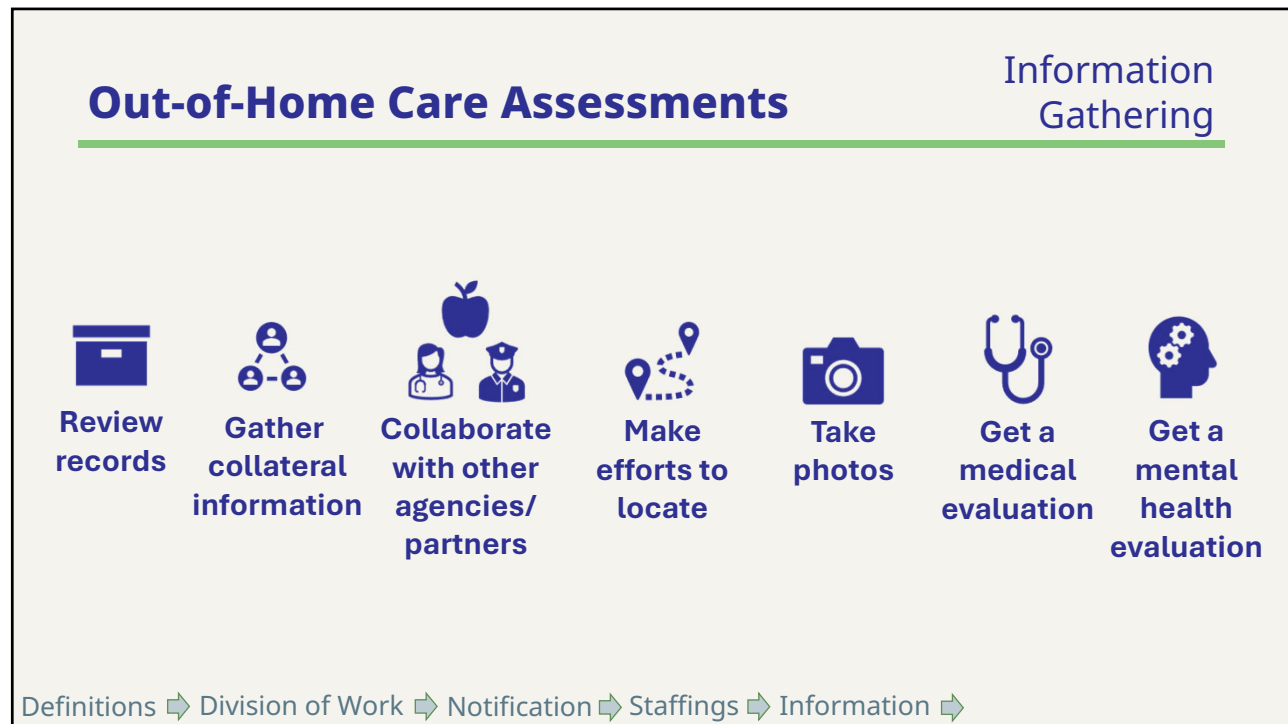

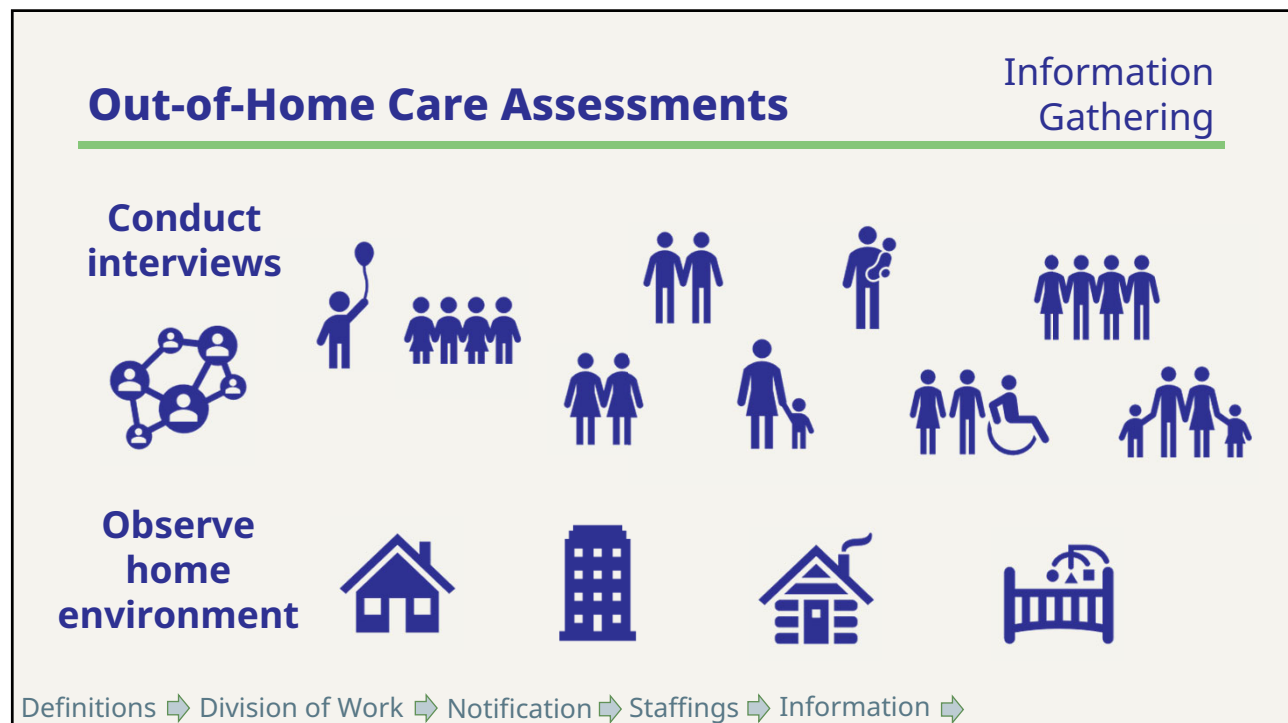

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Maltreatment in Care

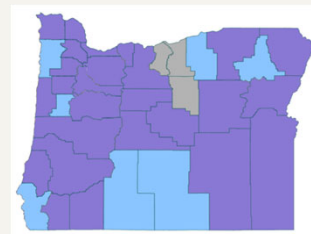
Performance Measure

The rate of victimization per 100,000 days of foster care of all the children in foster care during a rolling 12-month period.

Of the total number of days children spend in foster care in care during a 12-month period, how many instances of abuse were there for every 100,000 days.

National Standard: 9.07
