The Court shall maintain a list of qualified court visitors appointed by the presiding judge.

IT IS ORDERED that, in addition to the requirements in ORS 125.165, anyone who acts as a visitor in Clatsop County shall:

- Be licensed and in good standing as a physician, physician assistant, psychologist, family therapist, professional counselor, clinical social worker, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, nurse practitioner, lawyer, or have a post-graduate degree in social work, mental health, or medical fields;
- Have at least two years of relevant experience working with people with mental health conditions, intellectual disabilities, developmental disabilities, or geriatric concerns;
- Complete fiduciary training approved by Clatsop Circuit Court;
- Complete training on reporting child abuse and elder abuse; and
- Demonstrate knowledge of Oregon Revised Chapter 125.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the court visitor fee is a flat fee of \$300 per case, to be tendered by petitioner at the time of filing. This fee covers the visitor's mileage and other incidental expenses. Reasonable compensation for attendance at a hearing on objections is \$50 per hour. The objecting party must pay a minimum of \$50 prior to the hearing. If the objecting party demonstrates an inability to pay, petitioner shall pay the visitor's court appearance fee.
