## Required Abstract Proposal Elements

1. Presentation Title (max 20 words)
2. Primary Presenter Information (Name, email address, organization, state/ territory/country, and biographical sketch; max 100 words)
3. Other Presenter(s) (if applicable) (Name, contact information, and biographical sketch; max 100 words)
4. Learning Objectives (Two or three; max 25 words each)
5. Presentation Description (max 100 words)
6. Target Audience (with suggested level of participant expertise; max 75 words)
7. Audiovisual Requirements
8. Audience Engagement
9. Average Speaker Fee (If applicable)
10. Reasonable Accommodation Requests (If any)
11. Identify ability to appear in person, in Salem, Oregon on either March 4 or 5, 2027 between the hours of 8 am - 5 pm.
