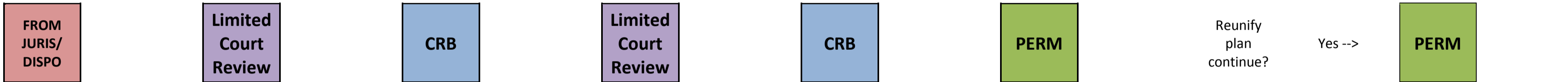

## TRACK 1: Standard Review



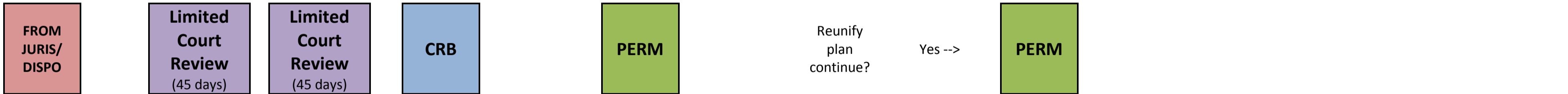
- 0-1 assessment factors identified on case information sheet.

## TRACK 3: Expedited Review

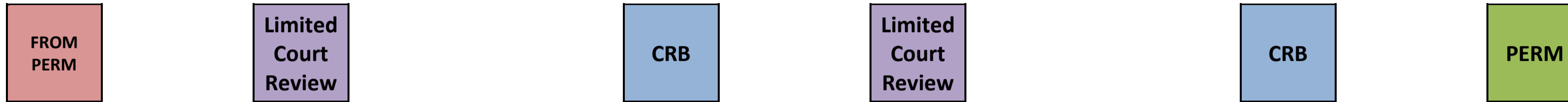


- 3 or more assessment factors identified on case information sheet.

## Post Permanency – Adoption Track



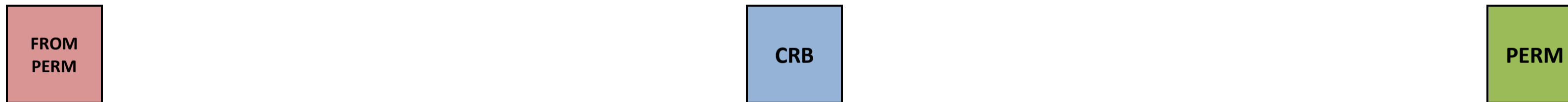
- Process continues until adoption is finalized.
- Once child is free, Oregon law requires a permanency hearing every six months until child is placed in adoptive placement.
- If court changes plan at permanency hearing to a plan other than adoption, the case follows the appropriate track.

## Post Permanency – Guardianship Track



- Cycle continues until guardianship is finalized.

## Post Permanency – PWFWR & APPLA Track



- Process continues until child leaves care or court changes plan at a permanency hearing to a higher level plan and then case follows appropriate track.
- Court can schedule an early CRB review.
- CRB can request that court schedule a limited court review or early permanency hearing.
