Children of Incarcerated Parents Bill of Rights

- Senate Bill 241(2017); effective 1/1/18
 - Sets out certain essential rights for children:
 - ষ To be heard and respected by decision makers when decisions are made about the child.
 - ষ To be considered when decisions are made about the child's parent.
 - ষ To be cared for in the absence of the child's parent in a way that prioritizes the child's physical, mental and emotional needs.
 - ষ To speak with, see and touch the incarcerated parent.
 - ষ To have a lifelong relationship with the incarcerated parent.



Children of Incarcerated Parents Bill of Rights

© Directs DOC in cooperation with a public body to develop guidelines as a set of guiding principles for policy and procedure decisions that impact incarcerated parents, and policy and funding recommendations with partners that adhere to the guidelines.
