## Event Statistics Reports



### What they measure:

1. Number of petitions filed
2. Number of hearings held
3. Average duration of hearings held

### Case types:

- Juvenile Dependency
- TPR
- Juvenile Delinquency
- Emancipation
- Judicial Determination
- Permanent Guardianship

### Key Data Entry Points

- Case type
- Petition type
- Courtroom Minutes:
  - Hearing Type
  - Result of **Held** or **Court-Appointed Attorney**
  - Duration (If a hearing concerns multiple cases, the Duration should be included on only one case record)

## Timeliness Reports

### Time to First Jurisdiction Finding

**What it measures:** % of dependency cases with a jurisdiction finding within 60 days of filing

**Starting Event:** Petition – Dependency (PTDP)

**Closing Event:** Jurisdiction or Dismissal Judgment or Order

### Time to Jurisdiction on Both Parents

**What it measures:** % of dependency cases with jurisdiction on both parents within 60 days of filing

**Starting Event:** Petition – Dependency (PTDP)

**Closing Event:** Jurisdiction or dismissal judgment(s) related to all causes of action on the case

### Time to First Permanency Hearing

**What it measures:** % of permanency hearings held within 425 days of filing

**Starting Event:** Petition – Dependency (PTDP)

**Closing Event:** Final day of a hearing with a *Hearing Type* of **Hearing – Permanency (HGPE)** and a *Result of* **Held**

### Time to First Permanency Hearing, Looking Back

**What it measures:** Days between the filing of a dependency petition and the first permanency hearing

**Starting Event:** Petition – Dependency (PTDP)

**Closing Event:** Final day of a hearing with a *Hearing Type* of **Hearing – Permanency (HGPE)** and a *Result of* **Held** or **Court-Appointed Attorney**

### Time to Subsequent Permanency Hearing

**What it measures:** Days between permanency hearings

**Starting Event:** Final day of a hearing with a *Hearing Type* of **Hearing – Permanency (HGPE)** and a *Result of* **Held** or **Court-Appointed Attorney**

**Closing Event:** Final day of subsequent hearing with a *Hearing Type* of **Hearing – Permanency (HGPE)** and a *Result of* **Held** or **Court-Appointed Attorney**

### Time to TPR

**What it measures:** % of TPR cases adjudicated within 182 days of filing

**Starting Event:** Petition – Termination of Parental Rights (PTTP)

**Closing Events:**

- Judgment - Terminating Parental Rights
- Judgment - Denying Termination of Parental Rights
- Judgment - Dismissal

### Time to TPR Petition

**What it measures:** Days between the filing of a dependency petition and filing of TPR petitions on all parents on the dependency case

**Starting Event:** Petition - Dependency

**Closing Event:** Petition – Termination of Parental Right (PTTP) events on TPR cases for each parent on the dependency case (**party records for both Juvenile and Parent parties must match those on the dependency case**)

### Time to Termination or Relinquishment of Parental Rights

**What it measures:** Days between the filing of a dependency petition and the date at which the rights of all parents on the dependency case have been terminated or relinquished

**Starting Event:** Petition - Dependency

**Closing Event:** Judgment – Terminating Parental Rights or Release – Surrender on TPR cases for each parent on the dependency case (**party records for both Juvenile and Parent parties must match those on the dependency case**)
