**Safety Conditions**

- You cannot have any weapons. No guns, ammunition, knives, or any objects being used or threatened to be used as weapons.
- Submit to fingerprinting and photographing when requested by the juvenile counselor if not already obtained
- Allow your JCC to search your person, home, car, and things. This includes your cellphone and other electronics. Your JCC may search if they reasonably believe they will find evidence that you have violated your probation.

**Curfew/Community Conditions**

- Do not run away from home
- You are placed on the  Electronic Monitoring Program  Community Monitoring Program for \_\_\_\_\_ days. You must follow the rules for the program.
- Abide by the curfew set by your parents.

### **Treatment Conditions**

Do not have or use any alcohol, inhalants, illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia (vape pens, pipes, etc.)

Do not use or have controlled substances unless prescribed by a licensed medical professional.

Submit to random drug testing which may include urinalyses, sweat patches, breathalyzers, saliva test, and remote alcohol monitoring.

Participate in mental health evaluation as directed by your JCC and follow the recommendations of the evaluator.

Participate in substance use evaluation as directed by your JCC and follow the recommendations of the evaluator.

### **Sex Offender Conditions**

Have no contact with victim(s) unless approved by victim and offender's therapist(s).

Have no unsupervised contact with children who are younger by \_\_\_\_\_ or more years. Supervision shall consist of the youth being within sight and sound of a responsible adult approved by the Juvenile Court Counselor (JCC) or Court, who is aware of the youth's conditions of probation.

No babysitting. This means caring for children. It does not matter if you are not being paid.

Not possess or use at any time any type of pornography. Do not frequent establishments associated with the sex industry.

Consent to and cooperate with polygraph examinations when deemed necessary by the therapist and/or Juvenile Court Counselor.

Enter, participate in, and complete sex offender treatment and/or education as directed by JCC.

Submit to blood and buccal testing for DNA purposes - and HIV testing with release of information to victim(s).
