Safety Framework Implementation Plan

Members of our Model Court team participated in JCIP’s 2025 Safety Framework Training pilot and developed this implementation plan for our local use of the framework by legal professionals in dependency hearings. During the training, attendees participated in a cross-system and discipline group planning designed to generate a shared vision and action steps for advancing safety framework practice in our dependency practice.

This information was used to create this implementation plan, which will be updated as our legal professionals improve their practice over the following months and attend further training. The implementation plan is best utilized by cross-system teams as a “working document” for implementing the practices from the framework as prioritized during the training.
