The orders and judgments in this report were identified using Odyssey's Event Listing report. They include judgments entered with codes JGPE (Judgment-Permanency) and JGCR (Judgment-Complete Review) for all Judicial Districts and codes ORJL (Order-Judicial Review), ORJP (Order-Juvenile Permanency), and JGRW (Judgment review) for Districts 3, 4, 7, 10, 16, 20, 23, 24, and 25. Citizen Review Board (CRB) staff then manually looked up each order and judgment and recorded the permanent plan in effect at the time of the hearing and the reasonable efforts and compliance findings. Staff also made a note if the hearing was not a Permanency Hearing or Complete Judicial Review. Those orders and judgments were removed from the results. The results also exclude a small number of orders and judgments that did not clearly identify a permanent plan in effect at the time of the hearing, and a small number of orders and judgments in cases that had been sealed.

A special thank you is owed to the CRB staff who collected this data while CRB reviews were briefly paused due to COVID-19.
