

NOTICE OF PROPOSED FEE INCREASE, OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT
Oregon Judicial Case Information Network (OJCIN)
March 14, 2022

The Oregon Judicial Department (OJD) has opened a public comment period on revised fees for use of the Oregon Judicial Case Information Network (OJCIN). The OJCIN system provides both free and paid online access to calendar and other court information. Comments on the proposed fee schedule are due no later than 5 p.m. on April 15, 2022.

The proposed fees are outlined in Chief Justice Order 22-004. If adopted, the revised fees would take effect on May 1, 2022, and continue to offset the costs of providing electronic access to court documents, technology support services, maintenance costs, hardware and software replacement, and other costs relating to state court electronic systems.

Persons wishing to comment on the proposed fees may send comments by e-mail to OJCIN@oid.state.or.us, using "OJCIN Fee Comment" in the subject line, or by regular mail addressed to "OJCIN Fee Comment," c/o Business and Fiscal Services Division, Oregon Judicial Department, Salem, OR, 97301. All comments must be received by 5 p.m. on April 15, 2022.
